

2012 small boats electrofishing


2013 925 tonnes landed

Joint Interventions

1 manslaughter conviction
1 criminal investigation of tax fraud
50 civil tax evasion investigations
14 cases reported to prosecutor for fishing violations

Enforcement not working

Too profitable to stop Gaps in the law Gaps in data Difficulties in detection

















Solution – legalize and control?

April 2017 Scottish Government authorised a limited trial electro-fishery for razor clams

Designed as a scientific investigation to gather information about electrofishing

Trials will take place in designated areas.

A small number of boats will be authorised

All other razor clam fishing will be prohibited

Supply chain can be monitored and controlled
